STD I

Leaf Printing Activity

Materials:

Leaf, paint or watercolour, paper

Steps:

Pick a leaf from the garden.

Apply paint or watercolour on one side of the leaf.

Place the painted side on the paper and press it gently.

Carefully lift the leaf to see the print.

Use the leaf prints to create beautiful designs. (2 or 3)

STD II

Nature Care Project

Do three activities to care for nature:

Water a plant

Feed birds

Save water

Assignment work:

Draw or paste pictures of the activities done and write one sentence about each.

STD III

Best out of Waste

Make a Pencil Holder from Old Cardboard

Materials:

- Old cardboard (cereal box, etc.)
- Scissors
- Glue or tape
- Markers, paint, or stickers for decoration
- Ruler or scale

Step-by-Step:

1. Cut the Cardboard: Cut a rectangle from the cardboard (size depends on desired holder height).
2. Shape the Holder: Roll the cardboard into a cylinder and secure with glue/tape.
3. Decorate: Use markers, paint, or stickers to make it colourful.

STD IV

Kerala Food Chart

Activity: Make a chart showing famous foods of Kerala.

Instructions:

- Take a quarter size chart paper.
- Write the title “Famous Foods of Kerala” at the top.

- Draw or paste pictures of different Kerala foods.
- Write the name of each food below the picture.
- Decorate the chart with colours, borders, or small drawings to make it attractive.
- Keep the chart neat and clean.

STD V

Forest Model

Materials Required:

- Origami / Japanese paper (green, brown)
- A4 sheet
- Glue
- Scissors

Steps:

1. Fold or cut green origami paper to make trees.
 2. Use brown paper to make the tree trunk.
 3. Paste the trees on the A4 sheet to create a forest scene.
 4. Add small animals or birds using coloured paper.
5. Write a quote below the model.

STD VI

Mini Museum Project

Create a mini museum box using a shoebox or cardboard box. Students can place small items or pictures related to ancient life, such as tools, pottery, and coins.

STD VII

Design Your Own Advertisement

Step 1: Choose a product (real or imaginary).
