As we pause and turn back to take a look at the year gone by, I feel immensely delighted and privileged to have a handful of yet another bunch of beautiful memories and proud moments to present before this elite gathering in the form of annual report 2022. This report surely represents the reflection of the journey of Bhavan's Varuna Vidyalaya during the academic year 2022-23.

## ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE

This year too the excellent results of our students in academics took us to the zenith of glory. In the SSE 2022, 72 out of 80 students secured distinction and 6 secured A1 in all subjects. The school topper is Alphons Biju scoring 494 out of 500 with 98.8%. Six students in English, 4 in Artificial Intelligence, 3 each in Sanskrit and Mathematics, and 1 each in Science and Social Science secured centum.

In the SSCE 2022, 70 out of 83 students secured distinction and 10 secured A1 in all subjects. Gourinanda R emerged as the topper in Science stream with 490 out of 500 (98 %) and LakshmiG Menon topped with 480 out of 500 (96%) in Commerce stream .Five students in Chemistry and 1 student each in Mathematics and Business studies secured centum.

Shikshan Bharathi Comprehensive Evaluation was conducted in the month of September. The team was led by Ms. Girija T S, Education Officer.

The Investiture Ceremony 2022-23 was held in the month of June and the newly elected prefectorial board of the School Parliament took charge.
